Planning for the three summer schools for British Columbia is underway and dates have been set:

Fraser Valley (Camp Whonnock, Maple Ridge) – July 17 - 21

Thompson-Nicola (Dutch Lake Community Centre, Clearwater) – July 10 - 14

Vancouver Island (Camp Bernard, Sooke) – within the period of August 16 – 25 (exact dates TBD)

The theme of this year's school is "Following in the Footsteps of the Dawnbreakers", inspired by the bicentenary of the Birth of the Báb.

The Regional Schools Coordinating Committee (RSCC) is inviting proposals for workshops and sessions on topics that can help advance a deeper appreciation of our response to the theme and wishes to see these developed from topics within the publication.

Each workshop should:

- Be interactive
- Be 1 to 1½ hours long
- Provide participants with practical understandings and tools so they leave feeling empowered and excited by how they can contribute to the betterment of society
- Be inclusive of friends of the Faith

We invite you to submit a basic outline of your workshop and explain how it is connected to the school's theme, indicating the school location(s) that you prefer to give your workshop.

The RSCC will then seek to integrate all proposals into a coherent programme to be offered at each school. Accepted proposals will be invited to provide a more detailed proposal by Ridván (April 21, 2019)
